Over the past six months of this year, we funded £1,814,619 worth of projects at University Hospital Southampton.



## Research

We have worked closely with the Research & Development team and funded £483,016 towards research projects.



We have also funded £475,000 of projects from our priority appeal including:

- Patient Wifi.
- Staff meal discounts.
- Website accessibility for patients.



- A specialist beauty therapist to work across all cancer wards providing therapies to patients undergoing treatment.
- Washbags and toiletries for Neuro patients admitted in an emergency or via the emergency department.
- Furniture including desks and chairs as well as craft materials for the new children's play retreat.
- Outreach art sessions in our medicine for older people wards.



# on kit and equipment including:

- A 4D eye scanner which allows a more accurate scan of the eye, making treatment and diagnosis
- A specialist trolley to transport an incubator in the air ambulance for use by the Southampton/Oxford neonatal retrieval teams.
- Reclining chairs for the new cancer ward side rooms, enabling loved ones to stay with patients during end-of-life care and treatment.
- A mobile projector, complete with an interactive games package for use on the paediatric cardiology ward.
